## **Rep. Fine Tours Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Facility**



**GLENVIEW, Ill.** – State Rep. Laura Fine, D-Glenview, recently toured the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (MWRD) plant in Stickney. It is the largest wastewater treatment facility in the world and serves 2.38 million people in the Chicagoland area. In addition to cleaning water from Cook County’s sewage and storm water system, MWRD has a storm water management program aimed at reducing the storm water damage to life, public health, safety, property and the environment. Fine explained to MWRD officials how her district was impacted by flooding earlier this year and advocated for more MWRD storm water management projects designed to help alleviate future flooding in the region.

“As our community recovers and works to prevent future flooding, it is important that all levels of government work together,” Fine said. “I look forward to working with the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District and others on this important issue.”
