Fine Appointed to House Committees

GLENVIEW, IL – State Rep. Laura Fine (D-Glenview) will serve on six committees in the House of Representatives, assignments the freshman lawmaker says will allow her to more effectively advocate on behalf of the concerns of her constituents.
