Rep. Fine Encourages Area Residents to Submit Bill Ideas for Upcoming Spring Legislative Session

GLENVIEW, IL – With the General Assembly’s spring session set to begin later this month, state Rep. Laura Fine, D-Glenview is encouraging local residents to contact her office to share any ideas they may have for new legislation.
